Summary

Premier League Reading Stars is a reading intervention targeted at pupils from Years 5 or 6 who are working below the expected standard in reading or who are not motivated to read.

The intervention gives pupils the opportunity to practise their reading skills and develop their enjoyment of reading, using football-related resources and texts.

Literacy Aims

- To improve reading motivation and frequency.
- To increase enjoyment of reading and reading for pleasure.
- To improve reading attainment.

Audience / Group Size

Year 5 and 6 pupils not meeting expected standards or who have a lack of motivation for reading

Up to 15 pupils

Time / Frequency

Recommended 10 x 1-hour sessions

Sessions are flexible to fit shorter time slots (from 20 mins)

Impact

- Pupils will make progress in their reading attainment.
- Pupils will enjoy reading.
- Pupils will read more.
- Pupils will identify their reading preferences.







Premier League Footy Phonics

Summary

Premier League Footy Phonics is an active literacy supplement designed to support and complement systematic synthetic phonics activities learned in the classroom.

Footy Phonics engages pupils through physical activities and the theme of football.

Footy Phonics enhances phonics programmes already in schools – it does not replace or impact the integrity of a school's existing programme/scheme.

Audience / Group Size

Reception to Year 2

KS2 pupils working pre-KS2

Pupils who are active but not engaged in phonics

Small groups of no more than 10

Time / Frequency

Up to 10 sessions that support phonics learning in the classroom

Literacy Aims

- To improve blending and segmenting skills.
- To develop recognition of Grapheme Phoneme Correspondences, including alternatives.
- To improve the application of phonetic knowledge and skills to decode unfamiliar words.
- To increase motivation and develop positive attitudes towards phonics and reading.

Impact

- Pupils will have an improved phonetical awareness.
- Pupils will be able to access class-based phonics learning.
- Pupils will have a positive attitude towards phonics and reading.







Premier League Magazine Team

Summary

Premier League Magazine Team is a programme designed to engage reluctant writers to work together to create a magazine-type format with multiple articles using different text types.

The programme is not an intervention but focuses on increasing writing for enjoyment and writing for engagement by allowing pupils to write for an agreed purpose and audience. The magazine is to be led by the pupils and can be about anything that they wish.

Literacy Aims

- To engage pupils and increase their enjoyment of writing.
- To increase writing motivation.
- To develop writing skills.
- To develop oracy skills.
- To inspire pupils.

Audience / Group Size

KS2 pupils not meeting expected standards or who have a lack of motivation for writing

Groups of 8

Time / Frequency

10 x 1-hour sessions

Impact

- Pupils will engage more with writing.
- Pupils will make progress in writing and spoken language attainment.
- Pupils will feel inspired to write for pleasure.







Premier League Primary Stars Social Action Project

Summary

The Premier League Primary Stars Social Action Project is a six-part programme designed to support young people in developing and implementing a positive change in their community.

The programme guides pupils towards the creation and delivery of their own "social action project".

Literacy Aims

- To improve pupils' confidence and motivation when participating in literacy activities.
- To develop oracy skills for pupils to confidently talk about social action.
- To develop teamwork and leadership skills.
- To inspire pupils to take up their social action.

Audience / Group Size

Upper KS2 pupils

Groups of 8-10

Time / Frequency

Suggested six sessions, but topics can be delivered across as many sessions as required

Impact

- Pupils will use their literacy skills to take social action.
- Pupils will make progress in English attainment.
- Pupils will feel inspired to use their voices to make an impact.
- Pupils will become leaders of the future.
