Extra time: Match reports with time

Introduction:

When we watch football match reports, the important information includes *when* everything happened, from the goals to the red cards. Can you summarise the timings involved in football matches?

Click on one of the match results and you will see a diagram describing all the key events of the match: goals, substitutions, red and yellow cards, added time.

For three matches, write 2 – 3 sentences which summarise the timings of the match. Try to include calculations – and show your working! Look at the example to help you.

Key

KO = kick off
 HT = half time
 FT = full time
 = goal
 = yellow card
 = substitution

Example:

- $47 - 9 = 38$ -> The first goal was scored 38 minutes before the half time whistle.
- $80 - 51 = 29$ -> 29 minutes passed between the first and the third yellow card.
- The first goal was scored at 20:12 or 8:12pm.
