Practise your interviewing skills!

**Interviewing is a great way to gather information.
You can learn a lot about something when you ask the right questions.**

In this week's challenge, we are asking you to become a sports journalist and think of a great question to ask a Premier League footballer.

Why not have a go and practise interviewing someone in your family or a classmate?

You could choose to carry out an interview about a topic unrelated to sport; it is up to you to decide what will make the most interesting story.

Perhaps you have always wanted to find out more about what your family member's life was like growing up - now is your chance!



To help you with your interview...

You could choose to carry it out in the style of a post-match press conference and set up a table for your interviewee to sit behind, while you ask questions from the press pack seats.
