Introduction:

We can use bar charts to present data in a clear way. Can you create some bar charts to show some results from Premier League matches?

Instructions:

- Read the match report for Arsenal v Liverpool below.

Liverpool won against Arsenal last week. Arsenal had nine **shots** at goal, including five **shots on target**, but Liverpool had 16 **shots** with seven **shots on target**. Liverpool enjoyed two **goals** from Coutinho and one each by Lallana and Mane. Oxlade-Chamberlain and Chambers scored one **goal** each for Arsenal, and Walcott made it a third despite missing a penalty.

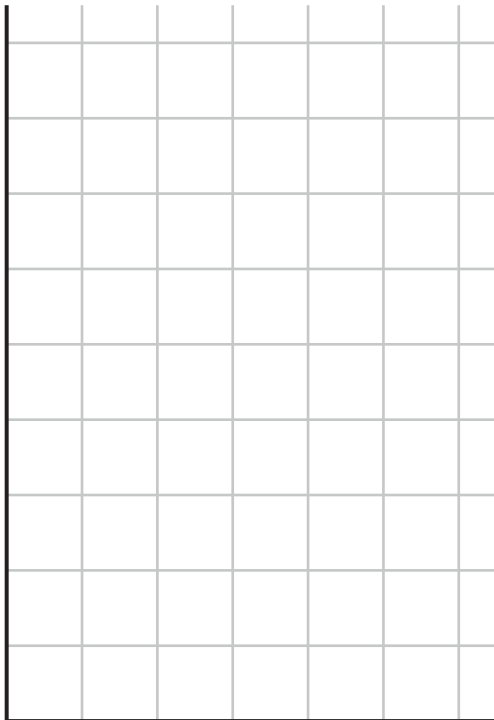
